- Distinguished Service Proposed second highest award, conferred upon a long-serving member who has conducted themselves in a particularly distinguished manner. No annual requirement, no limit to number of annual awards and no limit to the number a recipient might receive.
- Meritorious Service Proposed third highest award, conferred for a period and/or activity specific recognition. Johnny Thomas might be awarded this for all of his efforts at Field Day 2023. No annual requirement, no limit to number of annual awards and no limit to the number a recipient might receive.
- Annual Special Recognition Proposed as fourth highest award, conferred upon the individual that served the group in a notably effective manner for the entire year. Club Member of the Year designation. This one is probably best presented at the Christmas Party.

Each of these awards come from the Club via the leadership with any manner of nomination. A member at large can nominate to the leadership formally or informally or the officers themselves may initiate the discussion.
